This Private Chef Services Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the parties named below in connection with private chef services to be provided at a single event.

1. THE PARTIES

3. PRIVATE CHEF LABOR FEE

The Private Chef Labor Fee is determined by the confirmed guest count on the Event Date, per the schedule below:

Group Size	Private Chef Labor Fee
Dinner for two (2 guests)	\$550
Small group (5-6 guests)	\$1,500
Large group (10-15 guests)	\$2,500

Groups outside these ranges will be quoted individually prior to booking.

4. GROCERY & INGREDIENT REIMBURSEMENT

The Labor Fee above does not include the cost of groceries or ingredients. Chef will purchase all food and ingredients necessary to prepare the agreed menu, and will provide Client with itemized receipts or invoices upon completion of services. Client agrees to reimburse Chef in full for actual grocery and ingredient costs, in addition to the Labor Fee.

5. GRATUITY

A gratuity of twenty percent (20%) will be added to the total invoice upon completion of services.

6. PAYMENT TERMS

- Deposit: A deposit of \$_____ is due at the time of booking to confirm the Event Date and reserve Chef's services. This deposit is applied toward the total balance due.
- Balance: The remaining balance — Labor Fee, grocery reimbursement, and gratuity — is due in full on the day of service, no later than the completion of services.
- Accepted payment methods: _____

7. CANCELLATION POLICY

Once booked and confirmed, cancellation of this Agreement requires written notice of at least five (5) days (120 hours) prior to the Event Date.

- Cancellations made with the required notice: the deposit will be refunded or, at the Client's option, applied toward a rescheduled date, to be mutually agreed upon.
- Cancellations made with less than five (5) days (120 hours) notice, or failure to appear on the Event Date: the deposit is non-refundable.

8. KITCHEN ACCESS & EVENT LOGISTICS

Client shall provide Chef with reasonable access to a fully functional kitchen, necessary appliances, and adequate workspace at the Event Location for the duration of the service.

9. DIETARY RESTRICTIONS & ALLERGIES

Client is responsible for disclosing, in advance of the Event Date, any dietary restrictions, food allergies, or intolerances affecting any guest. Chef will take reasonable care to accommodate disclosed restrictions but is not liable for reactions arising from restrictions not disclosed prior to the event.

10. CHANGES IN GUEST COUNT

Material changes in the number of guests from the count confirmed at booking may result in an adjusted Labor Fee, to be confirmed by Chef in advance of the Event Date wherever possible.

11. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

Chef performs services under this Agreement as an independent contractor. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create an employer-employee relationship between Client and Chef.

12. LIABILITY

Chef will perform all services in accordance with generally accepted food safety and handling standards. Client agrees to hold Chef harmless from claims arising from circumstances outside Chef's reasonable control, including but not limited to undisclosed allergies, pre-existing conditions of the kitchen or Event Location, or actions of guests.

13. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be held liable for any failure or delay in performance under this Agreement arising out of causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, extreme weather, illness, or government restrictions.

14. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

15. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the Event described above and supersedes all prior discussions or agreements, whether written or oral. Any modification to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
